Chairman's Annual Report 2015 – 2016

I would like to start my report by thanking Vice Chairman Councillor Mrs Anne Geoghegan and my fellow Councillors for their support which I have received in what has been a very interesting and challenging year.

The year started with the Elections, not only at Parish level but as you will recall the District together with the Parliamentary General election.

At the Parish elections 11 Councillors were elected unopposed which resulted in 4 vacancies.

I am pleased to say that 3 seats have been filled by co-option but with a resignation during the year this still leaves 2 vacancies. With that in mind it is the ideal opportunity to encourage any residents to consider if they wish to apply for the vacant posts.

The Best Kept Village, last year included some extra flower baskets and troughs placed around the village. The Parish Council received a High Commendation from the judges. With that encouragement we have entered again this year and fingers crossed we hope to do better.

In 2015 events at the Haling Dene Centre included – the Church Fete, Fun Run, Band Concerts and a very successful Pantomime. I am happy to say these will also be repeated during 2016. In addition we are preparing for the Party to celebrate the Queen's 90th Birthday on Sunday 12th June; there will be details of this event announced in the near future.

I am sure everyone has noticed the Haling Dene's new entrance and exit signs and new Notice board – which have been recently erected. The Haling Dene Centre continues to be used by many groups as a Community Centre, together with local organisations. We also have families who use our rooms and lovely grounds for their special occasions including weddings and parties.

The Council are also now looking for nominations for this year's Civic Award and Young Persons Award. Please nominate someone you think deserves recognition for their public service.

The Council continues to support local organisations with the consideration of Grants in accordance with the Council's Grant Awards Policy. The Council's aim is to distribute grants in a way that is fair and accountable to enable many groups to benefit. The Council have reviewed the Grant Policy and this has been updated. Council will now only be considering grants once per year at the June Full Council meeting.

Planning Issues – the Parish continues to comment on applications sent by the District Council. The Parish Council gives comments, or voices concerns to the District Council, in the Consultation process.

We have seen the completion of the New Fire Station and the Pencric Development of residential apartments for the Elderly.

The large new Housing estate on Lyne Hill has now started and we are led to believe that show homes are due to be ready after Easter. We will look forward to the completion of this development over the next few years.

The redevelopment of Riverside House has started with the demolition of the present structures and the construction of more Apartments for the Elderly. This is due to start in the near future.

On the outskirts of the village at New Acre Stables we await the outcome of 2 Appeals against refusal to allow residential development of the Green Belt. There has been 1 Appeal dismissed.

The Parish Council have seen the imposition of the speed limit of 30mph through the village and this was supported and welcomed by the Council. Additional signage has now been provided by the Highway Authority.

I must now mention the Library. I am pleased to report that due to the efforts of a dedicated group of residents, the 'Friends of Penkridge Library', together with the support of the Parish Council it has been possible to convince Staffordshire County Council the role of the Library is vital to the residents of Penkridge. It has now been rescued from the possibility of down graded to be run by Volunteers. It will now continue to be run by Professional Librarian staff with some variations in opening times. There may be opportunities for the increased use of the buildings by other groups and these are being investigated by ongoing discussions with the SCC.

Each month the Council have been grateful to Reverend Sheila Finn for leading prayers prior to the Council meetings and to PCSO Andy Poxon and his colleagues for presenting useful police reports and his continued his presence in and around the Village.

By September 2015 the revised Council Administration team was complete. The new team is led by Lesley Griffiths, the new Parish Administrator, together with Debbie Turton, Ann Raby and Hilary Lewis, who is a welcomed new member of the team. We hope that the best possible service continues to be provided by the Parish Council to the local community. We also have an excellent support team with Kerry Bagnall as our Bar Manager, Julie Rathbone and Caroline Draper headed by Bill Strickland who help maintain the Haling Dene and all the Council's facilities and amenities throughout the Parish.

Financial resources have been used responsibly and as a result this continues with the Precept remaining unchanged at £210,000 for the next financial year 2016-2017. I would like to thank the Sub Committee members led by Chairman Cllr John Eastwood (Recreation and Amenities) and Chairman Cllr Mrs Pet Hughes (Haling Dene Management). Indeed all Councillors are thanked for their contributions over the past year.

The development of the new Parish Council Website and Social Media continues by the Website group with a major contribution by Councillor David Oldfield.

Councillor John Eastwood has once again led the Highways Liaison group and continues the dialogue on highways and safety matters with the Highway Authority.

I finish by offering everyone involved with the Parish Council and the local community best wishes for the forthcoming year and the future.
