Further to items raised within the Public Participation Section of the March Full Council meeting in relation to the above, to consider

- Members of the Cherrybrook Action Committee asked if they could have the Parish Council's support in making an application to South Staffordshire Council asking that reassurance be given that no further development would take place in the Village until 2028 as per their documentation.
