The volunteers who have maintained the reduced service over the last 18 months are so happy to see their colleagues back and lots of training is presently going on. We understand that for families with children and those who have been shielding or working that our hours have been very restrictive. We hope the new opening hours will go some way to assisting all old and new customers to start visiting us again. We have a large selection of new books waiting to be borrowed. We have so many Children's books and the latest CRIME and FICTION titles by some of the most popular authors. There are no fines for overdue books at present so do not delay, pop in and see us soon.

<u>Safety first:</u> We will continue to maintain strict COVID RULES, so please be patient if we ask you to wait outside the door until people leave the building. We will still be having to limit the number of borrowers in the library at any one time.
