South Staffordshire Council PARISH AND DISTRICT COUNCIL ELECTIONS

South Staffordshire Council will be hosting a briefing session for potential district and parish council candidates in respect of the upcoming elections on Thursday 4 May 2023.

The elections are for all district and parish council seats in South Staffordshire. For the first time, voter ID will be required to cast your vote in person. You do not need photo ID to vote by post.

Nominations for the elections close at 4pm on 4 April 2023, meaning all paperwork and other documentation must be submitted and accepted by that date.

Anyone seeking to stand as a candidate in the May elections is urged to attend a briefing session scheduled on 22 February 2023 at 5.00 pm. The session will be held at South Staffordshire Council, Wolverhampton Road, Codsall, South Staffordshire, WV8 1PX.

Introduction

From 4 May 2023, voters in England will need to show photo ID to vote at polling stations in some elections. This will apply to:

Local Elections



Police and Crime Commissioner Elections

UK Parliamentary By-elections

Recall Petitions

From October 2023 it will also apply to UK General elections.

Accepted Forms of Photo ID

You can use any of the following accepted forms of photo ID when voting at a polling station.

International Travel

Passport issued by the UK, any of the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, a British Overseas Territory, an EEA state or a Commonwealth country

Driving and Parking

Driving licence issued by the UK, any of the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, or an EEA state (this includes a provisional driving licence)

A Blue Badge

Local Travel

Older Person's Bus Pass

Disabled Person's Bus Pass

Proof of Age

Identity card bearing the Proof of Age Standards Scheme hologram (a PASS card)

You will only need to show one form of photo ID. It needs to be the original version and not a photocopy.

Out of Date Photo ID

You can still use your photo ID if it's out of date, as long as it looks like you. The name on your ID should be the same name you used to register to vote

If you don't have an accepted form of photo ID

You can apply for a free voter ID document, known as a Voter Authority Certificate, if:

you don't have an accepted form of photo ID

you're not sure whether your photo ID still looks like you

you're worried about using an existing form of ID for any other reason, such as the use of a gender marker

You need to register to vote before applying for a Voter Authority Certificate.

Voting by Post

If you know that you won't be able to get to the polling station on polling day, you can vote by post.

You can apply for postal vote because you're away on holiday or because your work schedule means you can't get to polling station. You can also choose to vote by post simply because it would be more convenient for you.

You can apply for a Postal Vote from The Electoral Commission or South Staffordshire Council.

You will be a sent a postal vote ballot pack before the election.

Application Deadline in England

The deadline to apply for a postal vote for the elections on 4 May 2023 is 5pm on Tuesday 18 April.

You must also be registered to vote by 11:59pm on Monday 17 April.

Where to send your completed form Postal Vote Application

Once you have completed the form and made sure you have signed it, you need to send it to the electoral services team at South Staffordshire Council.

You can send your form by post. The Electoral Services team at South Staffordshire Council may also accept a scanned copy of your form by email, but you should check with them first.

You must return your postal vote application form by 5pm, 11 working days before the poll.

If you can't post your postal vote pack in time, you can take it your polling station or to your local council on polling day.
